


MFA adds an additional layer of security by verifying not only that the person *knows a password*, but that the person also has *access to a registered device*, like a personal smartphone. NCOCC has partnered with Cisco Duo, a system that makes it easy for you to enable MFA.

How to enroll a device to use Cisco Duo MFA


Click Start setup.




Choose what type of device you are using.




Enter your cell phone number. Click checkbox and confirm number you typed is correct.




Choose the type of phone you have from the selection below.




Install the Duo Mobile app if you don't already have it installed.




Launch the Duo Mobile app and click the **+Add** then click on **Use QR Code**.
